"IBEW 347 Family. I was recently diagnosed with Prostate Cancer, and I feel the information I learned is important to share with vou. My wife and I participate in the IBEW LU 347's health screening each year. This year they added a new blood test to the screening. It is called a PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen) test. I was unaware of the test until I received my results. While reviewing my results, I learned my PSA was a 10. The normal range is 0 to 4, anything over that is cause for concern. I scheduled an appointment with my family doctor. My doctor drew blood and requested another PSA test. In the course of a month, my PSA number had increased to 12.8. A side note here, I had no symptoms that anything was wrong. My doctor referred me to a urologist. Urology tests came back, confirming prostate cancer. They scheduled a PET Scan to get an idea if the cancer has spread beyond the prostate or not, lucky it had not yet. Biopsies were taken of the tumors. The results stated that I had a very aggressive form of prostate cancer. "As of 2017, in the United States, a man has a 50% chance of developing some type of cancer in his lifetime. Prostate cancer is the second leading cause of cancer death in men. Early detection gives you the best chance of stopping cancer from spreading and makes your prognosis for recovery much better." Book: 100 Questions & Answers about Prostate Cancer by Pamela Ellsworth, MD. Men and women, please take the time to talk with your family about this and ask the uncomfortable questions about your family medical history. I learned that my mother's side of the family has a history of cancer. I did not know about it until after I told them of my diagnosis. I am only 50. However, I should have been tested 5-10 years earlier for prostate cancer due to family history. My daughters should also be screened for cancer earlier than what is recommended due to my family history. By participating in the union's health screening, it allowed for early detection, effective treatment plan and positive outcome. Had I not done the health screening my prognosis would not have been good given the aggressiveness of my strain of cancer. I hope this helps you take the next step and sign up for the health screenings, see your doctor for annual exams, and ask your family about your medical history. It can save your life. If you have questions feel free to reach out to me. Wishing you the best." -Dustin E.
