~ Business Manager's Report ~

Sisters and Brothers,

There have been a lot of concerns coming in regarding the timing of deposits and the continued stress from CompuSys. I would like to thank all of you for your patience during this transition, as I know this has been a trying time. We are getting closer to switching everything over to our new TPA. All of our problems are not going to be fixed on day one. We will keep working through all of the issues that arise until they all get fixed. An audit has begun on the H&W side of our plan. Once that is done, they will start the pension side.

The Des Moines Inside negotiations have come to an end and we had the largest turnout we have ever had at a ratification/allocation meeting. Over 200 Brothers and Sisters showed up to our special meeting April 27th. EP2 negotiations are still ongoing; Keystone and Residential are about to start negotiations of their own.

Recently, we've had a lot of members working outside our jurisdiction. When doing so, make sure you are registered on ERTS by calling us here at the Union Hall, BEFORE you leave. Once you get to another Hall's jurisdiction, make sure you check in at that Union Hall. Checking in consists of seeing their Dispatch/Referral Agent and letting them know your information, which contractor you are working for and how long you'll be working in their jurisdiction. Keep in mind, each Union Hall is different.

The JATC is getting ready to start having OSHA 10 classes this summer. You will need to sign up just like you do for continuing ed classes. Call the hall if you need help with that. If you are a CW, you will need to get this done THIS SUMMER. Do not try to wait for the last class, as it may be too full. On another note, the JATC is partnering with Milwaukee to award an Apprentice of the Month. Each month it is announced on their Facebook page. We will make sure to share it on our page as well as put it in the monthly newsletter.

The Scholarship Committee met at the end of May to go through the seven submitted applications. The three finalists for the LU347 Scholarship will be announced in the July Newsletter.

Primaries are coming up June 4th. We are supporting Lanon Baccam for the 3rd congressional seat, and Larry McBurney for HD44. Our own Matt DeAngelo is running for Warren County Supervisor in District 2. If you live in Warren County, he would love nothing more than his Brothers and Sisters' support.

A few people have reached out about what they need to do in order to volunteer during meeting nights or at our events (like the Annual Picnic coming up this month). All we need from you BEFORE the meeting or event is a copy of your certificate of completion from your completed ServSafe course, if you want to help with the food prep or cooking. If you haven't taken the course yet, it's simple and only takes about an hour (mostly videos). Once completed, please email your certificate of completion to Nichole at the Union Hall and

she will document it and then get a copy to Misty for reimbursement of the \$15 course. If you have any questions or any trouble with this please reach out to us at the Hall.

NOTICE OF DUES INCREASE FOR JULY 1st, 2024

The Delegates of the 40th IBEW International Convention, which was conducted in Chicago, Illinois, during the week of May 9, 2022 through May 13, 2022, approved several amendments to Article IX of the *IBEW Constitution*. Accordingly, effective July 1, 2024, there will be an increase of one dollar (\$1.00) for the per capita that is paid to the General Fund, and therefore, the rate for all members shall increase. The following rates will apply to the international office portion of all monthly dues payments covering July 2024, and thereafter:

As always there has been a push for locals around the country to sign up new members. Strength in numbers as they say. This year's theme is simply... **MOTIVATE, EDUCATE, ORGANIZE.** Since 1970, at the height of organized labor, Union membership has been declining. Unions have seen a significant decrease in numbers due to outsourcing, high cost of materials, and/or limited amounts of resources. To put it plain and simple labor is just cheaper outside the U.S.. The International President has a goal to work towards for the next decade – to have one million members in the IBEW. **UNION STRONG** is the message that will be heard across the nation. This push for members is also echoed to our brothers and sisters to the north, in Canada, where IBEW is growing in numbers. Some of the political pushes that are seen today is the Invest in America Agenda, which has significant tax credits available for companies who want to build or expand their operations. Remember this phrase... <u>Unions are like insurance... it's selling a service.</u>

Locals across the nation mentioned some of the issues they were facing, such as, quality help, AI, and cloud-based products. TV stations were the most impacted by AI. If used correctly, it has the potential to increase viewers significantly. However, the downfall to AI is that it could mean job reductions in the workforce, alongside the continual issues always needing improvement.

Another big push for IBEW is the **CODE OF EXCELLENCE**. Basically, it is a set of workplace conduct rules to inspire a higher level of commitment on the part of Union workers and to demonstrate to customers that by hiring Union contractors, they will obtain a more productive, high-quality and safety-conscious work force. This is a dual function as it includes management's obligation to work with the locals and it ensures the workforce has everything they need to get the job done.

In closing, I would like to thank LU347 and our BA Dave Reid for sending us on this informative trip and I look forward to attending other functions that seek to enhance our Union and initiatives.
