~ Business Manager's Report ~

Sisters and Brothers,

Spring is upon us and its going to be another great year for IBEW and the electrical industry. Between the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act and the Inflation Reduction Act we are looking at a record \$1.9 trillion investment into this nations infrastructure. The greatest investment in American infrastructure in generations and Unions are reaping the benefits of this important legislation. From roads, bridges, and rails to broadband, solar, electric vehicles and America's clean energy grid, we are entering an era that again requires the use of Prevailing Wage, Apprenticeships and Buy America! There are massive energy grid and transmission projects being negotiated such as the SOO GREEN project that will deliver clean energy from the Midwest to the eastern market via a 525KV DC buried line connecting the MISO grid to the PJM grid. We are seeing continued investment into solar energy projects. The first two phases of the Duane Arnold Solar and Energy Storage project in Linn County will replace the retiring Nuke with 200 MW of generation and 75MW of storage capacity. And there are many others across the state of Iowa in the planning stages. The next solar project in our jurisdiction being a 100MW project going in down in Creston, IA for Alliant Energy. Nationwide, including across the state of Iowa, we are building an extensive electric vehicle charging infrastructure that will drive the demand for electric vehicles even further. Billions of dollars are being invested into electric vehicle infrastructure alone. These jobs are Union jobs. The IBEW has worked extensively with the Biden administration to be sure of that. These jobs are being laid at our feet. Now we have to live up to our end of the deal. We have to fill the demand for Labor. We have to get the work done. This is no easy task Sisters and Brothers, we will be put to the test. Our increased numbers of apprentices are not enough to meet the demand. Not even combined with our organizing efforts are we even close. Traveling Sisters and Brothers are to few to go around. With all of the work in the country they have options. The Chips Act will make it even more challenging with the scale of work coming from just that alone. Yes, finally, Manufacturing is coming back to America! Aside from all of the federal legislative advantages that have been handed to us, if we don't do the work someone else will. It's that simple. Don't fool yourself into believing that our non signatory competitors are incapable of doing jobs of any significant size because they are doing it every day. Across the country they are doing over 65% of our work every day. If you know someone experienced in the electrical industry or someone just thinking about getting started, have them give us a call. We can help.

In preparation for the electric vehicle infrastructure that is going to go in across Iowa, our training facility is now prepared to offer an EVITP certification course under the heading of journeyman training. This course will be available by July and it will count towards your continuing education for state licensing. Once these courses become available please be sure to sign up for them. This is a great opportunity to get certification for electric vehicle charging while getting the hours needed for state licensing. This will help us secure the NEVI projects here in Iowa.



The Bridgestone Electrical Apprenticeship is now accepting applications year round. You can pick one up at LU 347. Not to be confused with the Des Moines JATC, this is an apprenticeship program exclusive to Bridgestone. They offer seriously competitive wages and benefits. This is another great Union career opportunity. Please contact me with any questions.

Hello Brothers and Sisters,

I hope this finds you all well. I would like to take a minute to encourage you to register to vote. This is the bedrock of our nation and is the most basic step you can take to participate in our democracy. I would also like everyone to vote for pro-labor candidates, but that is for another time.

The easiest way to register to vote is online. You simply have to log onto the Secretary of State's website sos.iowa.gov. If you do this, you will simply click on the button that says register to vote. You can request a paper copy, or you can register online. Online is the easiest way to register, however you must have an Iowa drivers license or a Non-operators ID. If not, you will need to download the paper copy and mail it in/drop it off at your local county Auditor's office.


I would like to point out that if you have moved since the last time you voted, then you are **not registered to vote.** However, this is not a problem. You just log in as mentioned above.

If you are a felon, there is a button for that also. The process has been streamlined, so I would encourage you to register as well.

A footnote is that you must be registered 15 days before any elections, or there are more hoops to jump through, so it is easier to register now.


