– Business Manager's Report \sim

Sisters and Brothers,

You should have received notification from the IBEW LU 347 Electrical Workers Health and Welfare Fund regarding dependent enrollment. It is very important that we all return the form in order to comply with the Plans enrollment procedure. This mandatory enrollment protects the plan participants from higher monthly premiums due to fraudulent claims and/or inaccurate or incomplete participant data. During the early stages of this enrollment process, it has already been determined that there were 86 people listed as covered by the plan that should not have been eligible to receive benefits. Let's assume for a moment that there was no loss due to fraudulent claims activity. Even if that is the case, we are already paying higher rates for the ACA reinsurance fee, the ACA PICORI fee and stop loss insurance premiums due to the inflated dependent numbers. In addition, the contracts we have with our service providers are based on per member per month fees. We will save the plan money on the plans payments to VSP, Delta Dental, UHC and CompuSys. These numbers are significant. Another more important angle to think about; if a covered participant gets married or has children but fails to add the dependent (s), that plan participant could be responsible for any charges incurred prior to the dependent(s) enrollment. All of this information needs to be complete for your protection and the protection of the plan.

If you need any assistance completing the enrollment, need a new enrollment form or would like us to scan and send any information to CompuSys for you, please call the Union Hall. We will do whatever is necessary to get this done for you. 515-243-1924.

It's never too soon to think about your retirement. When you become a participant in the Local 347 Retirement and 401K Plan, you have an elective deferral option available to you. This option gives you the ability to contribute tax deferred money in addition to the amount contributed by the contractor on your behalf. This is a great vehicle for growing your retirement dollars and the sooner you increase those contributions the better off you'll be in the long run. The maximum allowable elective deferral contribution amount for 2015 is \$18,000. There is also a catch up contribution if you are 50 years or older of an additional \$6,000. We also have financial advisors available for anyone that would like to sit down and have a talk.

Just a reminder; Local 347 scholarships will be available to dependent children (up to age 26) of members of IBEW LU 347 in good standing. There will be up to \$3000 in scholarships (continued on next page)

given away each year. This is a one-time cash award sent to individual winners for study beginning in the fall of 2015.

Applicants for scholarships are evaluated according to academic ability, financial need, appreciation of labor, and social awareness. You are required to submit a 300-700 word essay (typed), the topic must be: "How has Collective Bargaining impacted my life and what role will I play in the Labor Movement going forward?"

Please provide a complete résumé. The résumé should outline the applicant's education (including transcripts from high school and college) and where applicable; work history, military service, special honors or awards and involvement in union, civic, community, or religious affairs. Applicants may be asked to provide a birth certificate and photo ID.

Materials must be addressed to IBEW LU 347, C/O Executive Board 850 18th St Des Moines Iowa, 50314 postmarked prior to May 1st of the scholarship year (2015) or delivered in person during business hours Monday - Friday 8am-4:30pm.
