A few reminders:

The Medicare education seminar will be held here at the Hall on Monday, August 3rd, from 5pm till 7pm. All members, spouses and adult children are invited to attend. RSVP with Misty at 515-243-1924

The next round of wellness events has been scheduled for Saturday, September 12th and 19th here at the Hall. The Fort Dodge area wellness event will be on Saturday, September 26th. As a matter of convenience, you do not have to be working under the Fort Dodge agreement to attend the Fort Dodge wellness event or vice versa. This valuable benefit is available to all 347 members, spouses and of course, plan participants, spouses and covered adult children. RSVP with Misty at 515-243-1924.

Beginning with the August premium, single Medicare-primary retirees will receive a 2.5% premium reduction. Medicare-primary surviving spouses of retirees will receive a 2.5% premium reduction. Married Medicare-primary retirees, regardless of the age of the spouse or dependents will receive a 5.0% premium reduction.

Permit to carry course at the Hall on Saturday, August 22nd. It begins promptly at 8:00 am. The 4 hour course will be \$65 per person. Training Specialists course covers two permits with one class: Iowa Permit and Utah non-resident Permit. A Utah Permit will allow for an additional 13 states of coverage. Should a member already have a permit and need to renew, they can attend the last two hours of this session for a renewal certificate. Cost for this session is \$35.00. You must arrive promptly at 10:00 am. You must bring your check with you for presentation prior to taking the course. Everyone must RSVP with Misty at 515-243-1924.
