## $\sim$ Business Manager's Report $\sim$

Sisters and Brothers,

This year's pin party will be held on Saturday, March 14th at the Marriott in downtown Des Moines. Congratulations to all of you that are receiving a pin this year. Please take the time to review the material included in this newsletter as the cut off dates for room reservation and your RSVP will need to be addressed rather soon. Call us with any questions.

Retirees, in an effort to assist with an unprecedented amount of work across the country, the Trustees of the NEBF and National Employees Benefit Board have issued a temporary return to work amendment. This will allow retirees to continue to receive benefits while working for up to 600 hours in covered and contributory employment. Once the 600 hours are worked you may return to the less than 40 hours per month as were allowed previously. The amendment is good for the calendar year 2015. In addition, the Trustees of the Electrical Workers Local 347 Health and Welfare Fund have approved an amendment allowing the retiree to return to retiree coverage following this event. This will allow you to return to retiree coverage after you complete your employment whereas before you would have been required to wait for 12 months after becoming a covered employee. Please come to the Hall to discuss this further if you are interested.

All participants in the Local 347 Health and Welfare Fund will be receiving the annual re-enrollment form soon. Please be sure to fill out all of the information, listing all current dependents. You do not need to resend Marriage or birth certificates if they have been submitted before but we must all fill out the required information. This audit procedure must be followed by each of us annually, it is absolutely necessary to protect both yourself and the Fund.

It isn't often that we witness the birth of a new Local Union, especially this close to home. President Hill has drafted a Charter for the Sisters and Brothers at Trinity in Newton. They are now proud members of IBEW Local 411, a manufacturing Local. This will put a tremendous responsibility into their hands while allowing them the freedom and flexibility to meet their own unique requirements. We are in full support and will provide them with any assistance as they take on this challenge. Congratulations IBEW Local 411.
