The first meeting of the 347 Investment Energy Conference was held here at the Hall on June 4th at 5pm. Present were speakers Dale Roshek with Principal Financial Group, Jason Trine, Director of Investment Platform Distribution with Principal Financial Group, Jack Anonson, Senior Portfolio Strategist and Portfolio Manager at Principal Management Corporation, Mike Sharkey of Prudential Investments, and our 347 Trust Funds Investment Consultant, Jeff Benoit. The IEC has a lot to offer each of us. There was a wealth of knowledge at this event and it is free to you and your spouse as a 347 member. The younger plan participants and investors really have a lot at stake here. The sooner you start planning for your retirement the better off you will be in the end.

Recently, the Board of Trustees of the Electrical Workers Health and Welfare Fund agreed to lower the premiums for our Medicare primary retirees. The results of this action are as follows; Beginning with the August premium, single Medicare-primary retirees will receive a 2.5% premium reduction. Medicare-primary surviving spouses of retirees will receive a 2.5% premium reduction. Married Medicare-primary retirees, regardless of the age of the spouse or dependents will receive a 5.0% premium reduction. For example, if you are a married Medicare primary Plan B retiree at the 80% rate you would be paying \$705.60 of an \$882.00 premium, now, beginning with the August premium, you will be paying \$661.50. That is a savings of \$44.10. If you are a single Medicare primary Plan B retiree you would save \$22.05, paying \$330.75 for that month's premium.

The Senior Health Insurance Information Program (SHIIP) counselors have generously agreed to put on a Medicare class for our members. This educational course will teach you about Medicare and all of the options and requirements involved. This is a terrific opportunity to have your questions answered and learn about the coordination of benefits with your current plan also. I would encourage you to attend not only if you are nearing Medicare eligibility or if you are already on Medicare, but if you are simply interested in learning about it now. We will all be Medicare eligible at some point in our lives, this is a great way to stay on top of the constantly changing rules. The class will take place on August 3, 2015 5:00pm – 7:00pm at the Union Hall. Call Misty to RSVP 515-243-1924.

The upcoming apprentice school year is going to be a busy one. The Electrical Training Alliance (formerly the NJATC) curriculum is now a full 5 weeks for all inside apprentices. With this full schedule our JW training opportunities this coming school year will be sporadic at best. In order to stay on pace to offer enough CEC classes to meet license requirements we are offering 20 – three hour classes in July. Many of the classes have the same course title and are identical in subject matter. When you sign up for a class, **verify the dates of that class**.
