Apprenticeship News

The most consistent aspect of any apprenticeship program is the fact that it is constantly changing. The Des Moines Electrical Apprenticeship is no exception.

Since being hired in early March 2015, one of my first tasks as the new director has been to secure two new instructors. The Trust has hired Charlie Harned and Heather Talbot to fill the full-time openings created by the loss of a long-time instructor and my change of position to the training director. During this timeframe, Brother Rod Olson agreed to come out of retirement to fill the gap allowing the apprentice training schedule to be completed in a nearly seamless manner. The JATC, apprentices and staff would like to express our sincere thanks for his cooperation, willingness and dedication to the industry and our apprenticeship program. Please thank Rod when you have an opportunity.

As a result of this change in the instructional staff, we found it necessary to amend our preliminary plans for journeyman training for the coming summer. Because of the State of Iowa requirements, we are currently in the process of qualifying our new instructors to become state approved instructors for continuing education courses. We expect those approvals to take place in the near future. In the meantime, we will be planning and setting tentative JW continuing education classes. The current plan is to begin offering classes in mid June 2015. Please continue to check the JATC's website, www.dmelejatc.org, for available journeyman training classes.

Moving forward, we would like to expand the JW training by supplementing classes offered by the full-time instructors with part-time instructors. If you have a particular area of expertise that you would like to share, we want to talk to you. If you think you would like to instruct but not full-time, we have courses already developed you could instruct. It will be a similar process to get state authorization for a part-time instructor as it is for the full-time instructors. Call for more information.


