It is vital that these be kept up to date in order to protect your current dependents from unexpected financial hardships due to your loss. If you have experienced changes in your life such as marriage, divorce, or have another child, you should update your beneficiary designation right away.

The IBEW 347 Health and Welfare Plan will be starting preparations soon for the next round of wellness exams. You are welcome and encouraged to attend these each year. Last year the test detected a cancerous tumor in a young woman that would not have known about it otherwise. Immediate action was taken and it was successfully removed. You will hear more about her story at some point but this is a defining example of the value of this benefit.

Congratulations to the Sisters and Brothers of IBEW Local 411 for their recent victory. Trinity Structural Towers filed for a decertification trying to force the Union out. This would have resulted in lower wages, longer hours and decreased benefits for the bargaining unit employees. They learned quickly that we are all proud IBEW members and we don't lie down. Once again, Congratulations IBEW 411, excellent work.

~ POLITICAL CORNER ~

Hello Brothers and Sisters,

This past month has been pretty busy. I've been up at the capitol lobbying our Senators and Representatives on a couple of bills looking to weaken the Unions and the middle class. One of the most important ones is called (TPP) Trans Pacific Partnership. For those who remember NAFTA this is far worse, this bill is NAFTA on steroids. TPP or another name for it is Fast Track.

What is Fast Track?

- -A process used to negotiate a 2000 plus page trade deal written by corporations to side-step our democracy.
- -It will mean our elected Representatives in Congress give up their authority to review and amend trade deals, which remove any chance of improving deals that hurt American workers.

How will it hurt American families?

- -It will ship American jobs overseas
- -It will drive down working wages
- -Will stack the deck AGAINST the middle class and be in favor of corporations.
- -Will destroy our system of checks and balances and give a blank check to the executive branch.

So for those who care about the union and American jobs please call Congress now and tell them NO to Fast Track. (1-855-712-8441)

There is another bill out there right now that Republicans and non-union contractors are trying to pass. The HF#47 bill states apprentices are allowed to be left on any job site alone for 75% of the time. We as the IBEW are against this because not only is it a major safety issue it is another way to undermine and underbid our contractors. Granted this bill is on the state level and we need to reach out to our Senators and our House Reps and let them know where we stand and voice our opinion.

A couple of notable events were held last month. The first was Union Hockey Night we had 50 seats reserved and last count I've had we had over 60 people show up. I think it says a lot about the direction we are heading. The Unions are getting stronger in Des Moines. On April 10 we had the Annual Polk County Democrat Spring Dinner. I was unable to attend this year but from everything I've heard and read it was the best one yet. April 14 and 15 we had Presidential candidate Hillary Clinton here in our great state. April 16 we had the Mayor of NYC Bill DeBlasioat attend a fundraiser for Progress Iowa. I had a lengthy conversation with Mayor DeBlasioat about the IBEW and unions in general. He is a man that is totally committed to work for the middle class.

In closing I would like to send out a special Thank You to all the apprentices that showed up for Lu#347's Labor Park clean up. You guys did a hell of a job and made me proud Thank You!
