Sisters and Brothers,

I wanted to remind you of a few scholarship opportunities that are available to us as Union Members. In addition to the Local 347 Scholarship which is awarded to the children of 347 members with applications due by May 1, there is the IBEW Founding Fathers' Scholarship www.ibew.org/FoundersScholarship available to all IBEW members who have been in continuous good standing for four years preceding May 1 of the scholarship year in which they plan to apply. Spouses or children of IBEW members are not eligible for the IBEW Founders' Scholarship. There is also the Jim Caffrey scholarship available through the South Central Iowa Federation of Labor with an application deadline of March 30 and the Union Plus Scholarship www.unionplus.org that has an application available starting in mid-June. We have applications for all of the scholarships at the Union Hall.

2016 is slated to be one of our busiest years. In order to fill the job calls, we count on the Sisters and Brothers from other IBEW Local Unions to come here and work with us. It is important that we recognize the importance of their contribution to our Local Union. Often times, their value goes unrealized.
