## **Apprenticeship News**

Just a reminder,

The JATC has offered over 100 JW training classes since the beginning of the code cycle January 1, 2014. More classes are planned but JW classes will be limited after July.

Available classes are always posted on our website.

If there are no classes shown on the website it is for one of two reasons. All the classes are at full enrollment or there are no classes scheduled.

Remember you need 18 hours of continuing education to renew your license, 6 of which must be a Code class. All 18 hours can be Code classes and you can take the same class more than once.

Please register for all Journeyman Continuing Education Units (CEU) using the on-line registration process on our website.

Do not put off completing all 18 hours of CEU's. There is no grace period for CEU credits into 2017. If you do not renew your license by December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016 you will have to take the state license exam!

To check your earned CEUs go to: http://www.dps.state.ia.us/fm/electrician/continuing\_ed/Continuing\_Education

Note that the instructor has thirty days to submit a course and the state updates the list about once a month.

The last week that CEU classes will be offered will be during the week of November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016 for the 2017 license renewal.
