Apprenticeship News

Many of you may already know that we have donated some of the equipment from the new building to Twin Cedars High School in Bussey Iowa. Twin Cedars High School desperately needed new cabinets and tables for their chemistry classroom. They received a \$3,000 grant to purchase new equipment but that will not be enough for them buy everything they need. We reached out to Twin Cedars to see if they could use any of the DuPont/Pioneer lab cabinets and tables. Twin Cedars is very grateful for the donation, as it now allows them to use their grant money for other items needed in their chemistry classroom.

The Des Moines Electrical Apprenticeship, Local #33 Plumbers and Steamfitters Apprenticeship and the Carpenters Local # 106 Apprenticeship have all agreed to disconnect, disassemble and reassemble the lab cabinets for Twin Cedars Schools. At this time, Stroh has offered a truck to deliver the equipment.

The first part of this project is complete.
