## ~ Business Manager's Report ~

Sisters and Brothers.

SPECIAL ORDER OF BUSINESS: CONTRACT ASKINGS FOR THE DES MOINES INSIDE AGREEMENT to be held at the February General Membership Meeting Thursday, February 8, 2018, 5:00pm at the Hall. 850 18<sup>th</sup> St. Des Moines 50314.

Next time you see Brother Terry Pohlman, thank him, he has attended every General Membership Meeting for the past five years, an extraordinary achievement!

Every election cycle is important, we all know that. This one is no different with the exception that we have been fighting an uphill battle against the current administration's anti worker legislation at an incredible rate throughout the entire 2017 session and we anticipate 2018 to be another contentious year. Due to their efforts we have seen bills passed and signed into law such as Workers' Compensation Overhaul - HF 518 limiting the amount a time a person can receive benefits, removing shoulder injuries from a whole body injury to a scheduled injury (this is a common injury in our industry) and no longer incentivizes employers to pay benefits on time, Private Drug Tests - SF 32 allowing private sector employers to drug test on hair samples, Qualifying for Unemployment – HF 542 requiring an employee to earn 8 times the weekly benefit before becoming eligible to receive unemployment, Workforce Development Board -- HF 572 changing the makeup of the board essentially removing any leverage that Labor once had, Banning Project Labor Agreements – SF 438 prohibiting state, county and city governing entities from entering into a Project Labor Agreement or similar agreement with a Union, agreements that secured work that we are doing today, OSHA Penalties - HF 529 striking specific dollar amounts for certain civil penalties for violating OSHA standards, Public Collective Bargaining – HF 291 arguably the most horrific piece of legislation in 2017 gutting the bargaining rights of 184,000 working people in this state and forcing them to recertify every bargaining unit prior to each contract expiration date.

These are just a few examples of legislation that passed and I urge you to read them yourself if you haven't already, but it didn't end when the session did, it continued as Iowa Workforce Development disqualified Union apprenticeship programs, including our own, from qualifying for Department Approved Training, a program put in place for over two decades, again tipping the scales against the most successful apprenticeship programs in the state. Union apprenticeship programs.

The good news is that we have a true Labor candidate running for Governor in November. A candidate that has a proven career fighting for working people. Senator Nate Boulton. Nate led the fight in the 2017 session against the anti family anti worker attacks. We were there with him when he battled on the Senate floor for Iowa's workers. Nate has been endorsed by over 30 Labor Unions including the IBEW State Conference. As President of the Conference I can assure you that we often struggle with unanimous endorsements in a primary but in this case the choice was actually very clear.

Here's what I need from you. I need you to attend your caucus on **Monday**, **February 5 at 7pm.** I ask for your support of Nate Boulton and I need you to try to become a delegate or alternate to the county convention. If you are successful in doing so, please call and let me know. I would like to track our progress. This election has the potential to tip the scales in favor of working families again. Be a part of it. Any questions on the process, please give us a call.

The Des Moines JATC will be moving all apprentice classes and administrative services to the new training center beginning in February, 2018. The schedule for this transition is as follows:

<u>Code Corner</u> – As of 1/1/2018, the State of Iowa adoption of the 2017 National Electrical Code has become effective. Per Iowa Statue, all of Iowa at a minimum will be held to the adopted 2017 NEC with the two following deletions:

210.12(D) AFCI – Branch Circuit Extensions or Modifications

406.4(D)(4) Receptacle – Replacement – AFCI Protection

Verify with your local AHJ as to whether or not they have adopted any further restrictions for the 2017 NEC through their ordinances.
