
Just a recap of this year's wellness event. We had 270 people participate, thirty three of which had high blood pressure that needs treated. We had one with possible peripheral arterial disease that requires further evaluation, one critical carotid artery result that requires immediate treatment. In addition, there was one possible kidney stone discovery, one abdominal cystic structure, four irregular heartbeats, one confirmed atrial fibrillation that requires treatment and 12 thyroid issues.

One of our young Brothers came forward and informed me that his thyroid issue was diagnosed as cancer, a cancer that was not present last year. Our young Brother went from participating in the wellness event, to confirmed diagnosis, to major surgery all within a matter of a few weeks.
