Hello Brothers and Sisters,

I hope all is going well with each of you and your families. The holidays are over and now it is time to move on to taxes and your favorite, the legislative session at the capitol has started. The word on the street is that they (and by they I mean legislators that do not back pro-working -class legislation) are taking it a little slower this year. The last couple of years have seen unprecedented attacks on union labor and though "they" maintained control of all three branches of government they did lose seats in the house and it got their attention. So that being said, so far, we have only seen legislation against unemployment i.e. can't collect the first week of unemployment when apprentices go to school. While this is still being debated it is a direct attack against working class people of this state. The other bit of interesting legislation that is still in a sub-committee was again attacking our apprenticeship. It is being proposed that apprentices have to be under supervision of a Journeyman only 25% of the time. Well this would open up a can of worms where they could have cubs running jobs for them and claim the journeyman just left. This is not acceptable. While we know that their licensing and ratios are not always up to standards it is difficult to police. We will see which way this all goes. I am a little cynical, but we are cautiously optimistic when we hear they are going to attempt to pass bi-partisan legislation. It would be nice if they would at least ask our input into the process and then tell us to pack sand instead of just ignoring our input. Baby steps. I would be remiss if I did not at least mention that they do have some pro-labor house files. I am not sure how far this will go if they even make it out of committee. The continuing battle for PLAs and another where making the bid process fairer should benefit us. It takes into consideration skill, safety and contractors experience building that type of structure. These considerations coupled with enforcing Davis-Bacon laws would greatly benefit union labor. We are just getting started and hopefully they can pass laws that benefit working class men and women of this great state.
