Senator Grassley: No friend of the working people of Iowa.

In a time when it's become increasingly difficult to plan for retirement, we are disappointed that Senator Grassley would introduce legislation that threatens the future of Iowans' pensions.

Last month as the holiday season kicked off, Iowa's longest serving Senator and chair of the Senate Finance Committee, surprised hard-working Iowans by proposing legislation that could bankrupt pension plans and significantly increase taxes on what little is left.

His plan is called the Multiemployer Pension Recapitalization and Reform Plan. It completely disregards the honest, bipartisan work of the Butch Lewis Act (H.R. 397) offered by the U.S. House and opts for a divisive, partisan plan that launches a new attack on union and employer partnerships. The Grassley proposal would drastically increase pension premiums and create massive new taxes on the wealth of workers, rendering our pension system unsustainable and resulting in government-induced market failure. This proposal is not bipartisan and no part of it is acceptable to the people of Iowa.

The Butch Lewis Act is the better proposal. It does not increase premiums and fees on healthy pension plans to support failing plans. Iowans who are enrolled in the multiemployer pension system already contribute payroll taxes on their pension checks. Now the Republicans want to take up to an additional 10 percent on top of that! Another fact is that workers defer wages on the promise of defined benefits being available to them in retirement. Congress should ensure this promise is kept, not promote a plan that would intentionally destroy stable pension programs.

The entire system, including the failing plans and the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation, could be made whole by taking back just one half of one percent of the 14-percent corporate tax break passed by Congress in 2017. Remember that in 2008, Congress gifted \$700 billion to bailout big banks and Wall Street. The Butch Lewis Act, however, is a loan program. It doesn't take advantage of taxpayer funds like the actions we saw in 2008 but does provide a large system that impacts thousands of Iowans with relief and stability.

IBEW members didn't cause this crisis. We have worked hard for our employers, paid for our pensions, and counted on the multiemployer pension system to be there for us and our families in our retirement years.

It's disheartening that Senator Grassley would forget his roots and introduce legislation clearly designed to be punitive toward retirees. We don't understand why Senator Grassley thinks the only way to assist struggling multiemployer pension plans be at the expense of healthy ones. His proposal would shift risk to individual retirees and increase the likelihood that the multiemployer pension system will collapse.

Why would Senator Grassley introduce a proposal so devastating for hard working Iowans? We are not certain, but we do know this will take more money out of the pockets of Iowans. Congress should focus on finding solutions to fix critical and declining plans, not introduce more risk to stable ones.

On behalf of the 9000+ electrical workers of the State Conference of the IBEW and all hard-working Iowans, we urge the Senate to pass the bipartisan Butch Lewis Act, (H.R. 397). It is a solid compromise to fix this crisis.

We urge you to call Senator Grassley and tell him to stand with Iowans on this and move the Butch Lewis Act forward. Senator Grassley, it's time to do the right thing. Stop shifting the burden to employees, stop punishing hard-working Iowans and start putting us first.

In less than a month, we will be the first state to participate in the 2020 democratic primary process. Yes, it's time to caucus again and while I know many of you have caucused before I want take a moment to lay out the process to anyone who hasn't participated in the past.

The Iowa caucuses (our version of primaries) are a process where over 2,000 town meetings take place simultaneously, during which you and your neighbors allocate delegates to the presidential candidates with the most support in your precinct. You can find your specific caucus location at the Iowa Democratic Party's Website: <https://iowademocrats.org/2020-caucuses/>. These individual meetings (caucuses) will begin **Monday, February 3rd at 7:00pm sharp** though I recommend arriving 15-30 minutes early because caucus volunteers will not let anyone into the caucus who arrives after 7:00pm. Note that you can register as a democrat at the door and participate, so don't let your current voter registration status hold you back!

Now that I've gone over the basics, I'd like to touch on the significance of the Iowa Caucuses. Simply put, our caucuses hold a lot of weight and will sway the course of the election primarily because Iowa is first. The candidate that wins the most delegates in Iowa will get a sizable bump and if they win the next 2-3 states, they will have a significant advantage over the other candidates (even though the first four states represent a relatively small number of votes). Another reason to attend is that caucuses typically have a low turnout and by caucusing with your fellow Iowans this year, you can have a larger impact on the 2020 election than almost any other voter. So if you have never voted because you don't think your vote matters, or have voted but not caucused, then seize this opportunity to nominate a pro-union candidate at your first caucus!
