## ~Business Manager's Report~



Sisters and Brothers,

At our February 11 General Membership meeting we voted on two Bylaws change proposals. The first proposal under Article X, Section 3(a) to lower the one time admission fee for a CW from \$50 to \$15. The second under Article X, Section 7(a) to remove the variable formula determining the assessment for Inside Construction and freezing it at its current lowest rate. Both proposals passed overwhelmingly. At this time we await final approval from International President Lonnie Stephenson prior to this taking effect. If you have any questions at all about the language changes please call or stop by the Union Hall at your convenience.

If you are an apprentice, you should be applying for unemployment benefits while attending school. When our lobbyist and I met with them recently, the Director and Deputy Director of IWD again confirmed that is still the case. If your employer is choosing to contest your claim, you also have the right to appeal.

As of January 31 we have had 1070 LU 347 Health and Welfare Fund participants tested for the Coronavirus, 113 testing positive. These numbers do not reflect any self performed test results such as Test Iowa or jobsite test results unless these folks ended up receiving treatment through our health plan. Total paid by the plan for testing so far is \$192,368.05, total paid for treatment so far \$131,478.61. Please continue to exercise caution during this pandemic. Although there have been significant improvements in the distribution of vaccines recently, we still have a hill to climb. Right now, Iowa's distribution to priority populations plan allows Phase 1B, Tier 2 manufacturing groups to receive the vaccine, depending on availability of course. This would apply to Sisters and Brothers of EP2 and Keystone for example. Tier 3 is expected to include construction. So stay safe and stay hopeful. We will get through this in the near future.

The building crew, Terry Pohlman, Scott Gardner and Aaron Haug have been working hard for some time now to get this project done and I know we all appreciate their effort. We currently have grading, site utilities and a significant amount of paving complete. CD's and Bid documents are out. We expect a GMP late February. First of April is a target date to get the Hall started and I am coordinating a ground breaking ceremony around that time. This project should move quickly once April rolls around. I have a full set of prints available on display at the Union Hall anytime you would like to view them.

## ~ Political Corner ~

The 2021 Iowa Legislative session is now in full swing, and some concerning bills are moving forward. A school voucher bill called SF 159 passed the senate and will be moving to the house, it would allow public funding to go to private schools rather than the public schools that we all benefit from. A pair of bills, SF 183 and HSB 55, would stop universities from using design-build for their construction projects. Another pair of bills, HSB 203 and SSB 1172 would add a one week waiting period for people claiming unemployment benefits and cut the time many workers are able to claim those benefits from 39 to 26 weeks. These bills are clearly not in workers' best interest so please take a few minutes to contact your representatives and let them know your position. They were elected to serve you, and they can't do that unless they know what you want! In national political news, House and Senate democrats introduced the Protecting the Right to Organize (PRO) Act early on in February. The PRO Act includes many benefits for union workers and workers that are trying to unionize, including an end to right-to-work laws, more protections for striking workers, and rules to ensure workers reach a first contract. Needless to say, the passing of the PRO Act would be a huge leap forward for working people across the country!
