

At our General Membership meeting held on February 10, 2022, the Sisters and Brothers of Local Union 347 moved by resolution a dedication of our new meeting hall in honor of Howell Hamilton "Harry" Broach .



Starting his career as an inside wireman at age 16 when he was initiated into I.B.E.W. Local 456 of Oklahoma City on April 29, 1909, Howell Hamilton "Harry" Broach transferred his membership to Local 347 of Des Moines in August 1915. He then helped organize the fledgling local before he was named International President of the I.B.E.W. In 1929, serving in that capacity through 1933.

Brother Broach was appointed an International Representative of the I.B.E.W. in October 1917, becoming one of the youngest members ever appointed to the International staff, and in January 1920, he became an International Vice President. Nine years later on December 7, 1929, following the death of International President James P. Noonan, Brother Broach was appointed International President by the I.B.E.W. Executive Council.

President Broach presided over the Brotherhood during the Great Depression, and his tenure was marked by a series of changes designed to enable the union to meet the challenges of the times. Among the many contributions he made to the union, perhaps none was more monumental than his rewriting of the International Constitution in 1930 (as authorized during the 1929 convention).

Poor health forced him to resign in August 1933. In November 1941, Brother Broach returned to the I.B.E.W. staff as an International Representa-

tive. At the 1946 I.B.E.W. convention in San Francisco, he was elected to the International Executive Council, serving as its secretary until January 1960, when he retired. Born on March 8, 1893, Brother Broach passed away July 25, 1960.

Shortly after he ascended to the union's presidency, his local saluted him in the February 1930 I.B.E.W. Journal:

"We are all real proud to think that our new international president, H. H. Broach, has his name on our roll call. ... We feel that the brotherhood has chosen a very capable leader who will surely do everything humanly possible for the betterment of the organization in all of its branches."



The 2022 legislative session is now well underway and I'm going to ask you all to call your representatives, but first I'll explain why. Like last year's session, there are some bad bills which have been proposed. These bills would hurt Iowa families if they were to be passed. The first bill would create a one week waiting period for all unemployment claims and shorten the maximum claim to 16 weeks, from the current 26 weeks, among other cuts. I don't

need to tell most of you that unemployment benefits can be a lifeline, allowing you to feed your family and keep a roof over your head during hard times. A bill like this would only help employers, and could be a disaster for working families.

There are a few bad bills related to schools and daycare centers as well. Like last year, we have a school voucher bill which would allow parents to pay for part of the tuition at a private school with tax dollars meant for public schools. People can send their kids to a private school, but it shouldn't be at the expense of the public schools that over 90% of Iowa children attend. Another bill would attempt to solve the shortage of workers at daycare centers by allowing each worker to watch more children. If you have kids, I don't have to tell you why this is a bad bill. Finally, some Iowa Legislators are working on a bill which would allow the state government to ban books from school libraries or classrooms. This kind of censorship, based on the whims of politicians, would restrict children's worldviews and their ability to grow and learn.

If you want these bills to be stopped, you need to call your representatives. You can easily find out who your representatives are and get their contact info online: <u>https://www.legis.iowa.gov/legislators/find</u> After that, a short 1-2 minute call is all it takes to let your State Senator or House Rep know what you want. The more of us who call, the more likely it is that these bad bills will be killed.
